

Completing a Project in Pathways

Example: Ice Breaker

By this point you have read through the project information, you have done the “Assess Your Skills – Before,” and have presented your speech and were evaluated.


After your evaluation you sign into Pathways, go to your Path and select your project. In this example it is the Ice Breaker.

Activate or Launch your project (launch in this case).



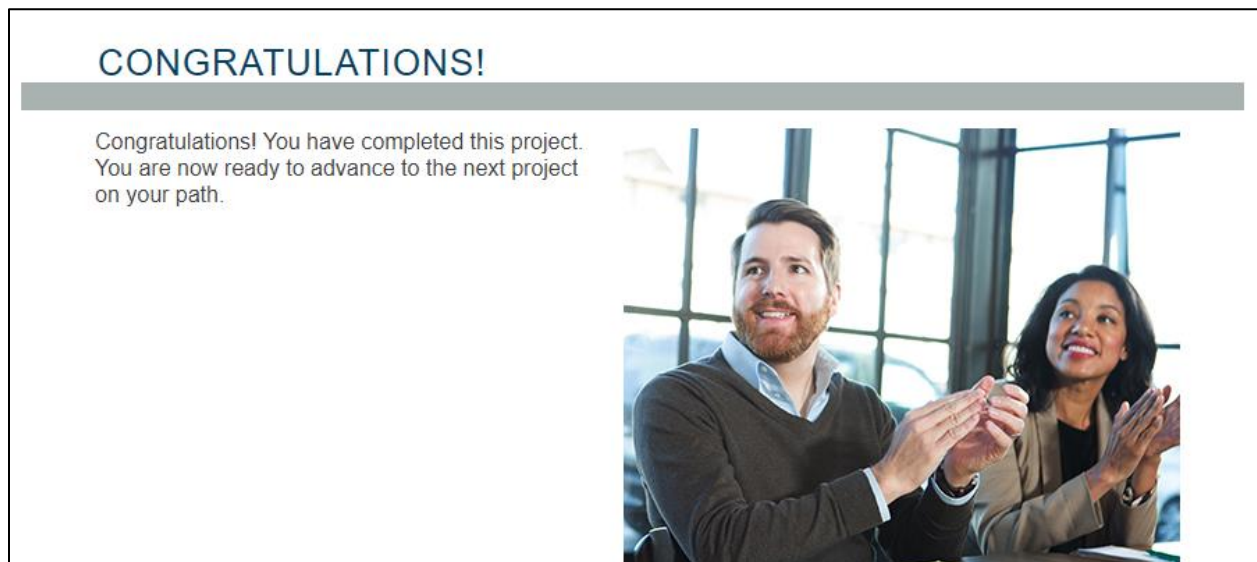
